One hormone, the human growth hormone (HGH), promotes body growth by accelerating protein synthesis. This hormone is also known as somatotropin. A deficiency of the hormone results in dwarfism; an oversecretion results in gigantism. Another hormone of the anterior pituitary is prolactin, also called lactogenic hormone (LH).

Hormone - A hormone is a chemical secreted by an endocrine gland and carried in the bloodstream to target organs where it performs a specific function. Functions of Hormones - The varying actions performed by hormones may be fast-acting (e.g. Adrenalin is a hormone that rapidly speeds up the heart and breathing rates when we get a fright), or may be slow-acting (e.g. Human Growth Hormone regulates the many body processes involved in growing from conception to death).
