The deed specified that the dividing line between the two territories extended from Little Egg Harbor to the northern Delaware River. George Keith was the first person to survey the boundary line in 1686, but he only completed two-thirds of his survey before halting because the West New Jersey proprietors claimed the line was located too far west.

Etymology. The state was named after the Delaware River, which in turn derived its name from Thomas West, 3rd Baron De La Warr (1577–1618) who was the ruling governor of the Colony of Virginia at the time Europeans first explored the river. The Delaware Indians, a name used by Europeans for Lenape people indigenous to the Delaware Valley, also derive their name from the same source.
