## **Different Types of Poultry Housing System for Tropical Climate**

No more than five poles shall be set at any one time by any person. Each pole may not exceed one inch in diameter. Poles shall be driven into the bottom, set no closer than 10 yards apart and the distance between the first and last pole shall not exceed 50 yards. Poles shall only be set, fished and retrieved during daylight hours.
